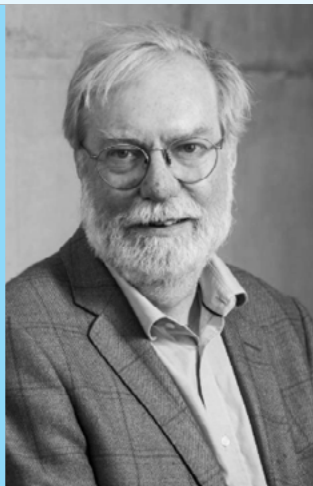
SIMON HICKEY

SIR PAUL COLLIER

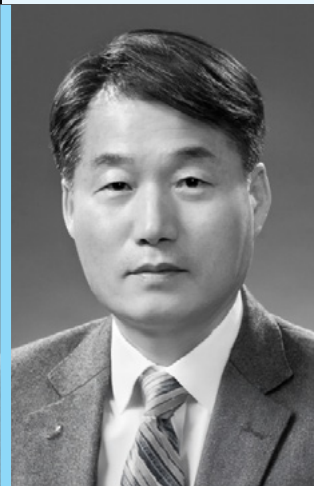
CBE, FBA
